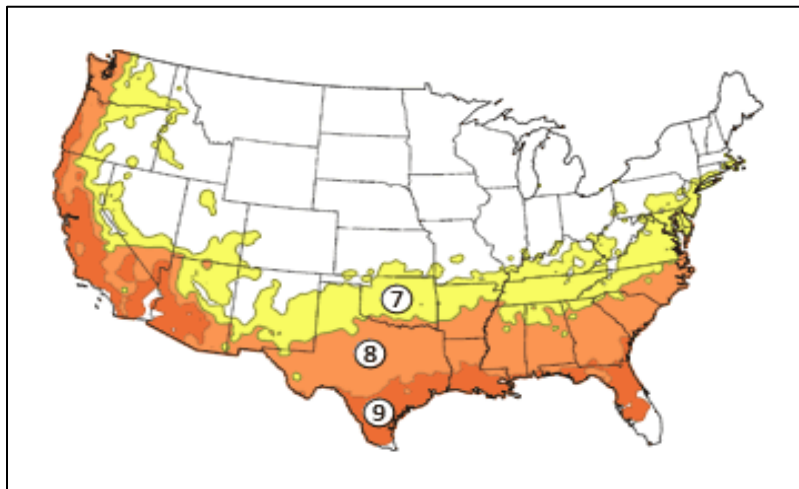


# CHECKLIST

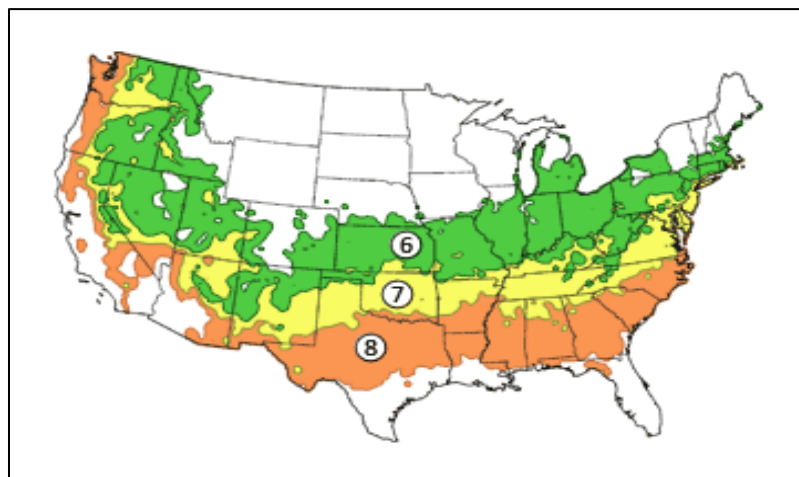
Revised and updated 7-25-18

- Correct species for hardiness zone, see Appendix A & B.
- Ample space for tree to grow tall and wide without interfering with infrastructure.
- Soil is not compacted and is not construction fill.
- Water source to provide regular watering during the first 3-5 years.
- Arborist mulch or woodchips.
- Tree protection material, fencing, stakes, zip ties, string or wire.

Appendix B: Hardiness zones for Giant Sequoias. They can be expected to grow in zones 6-8. \*
